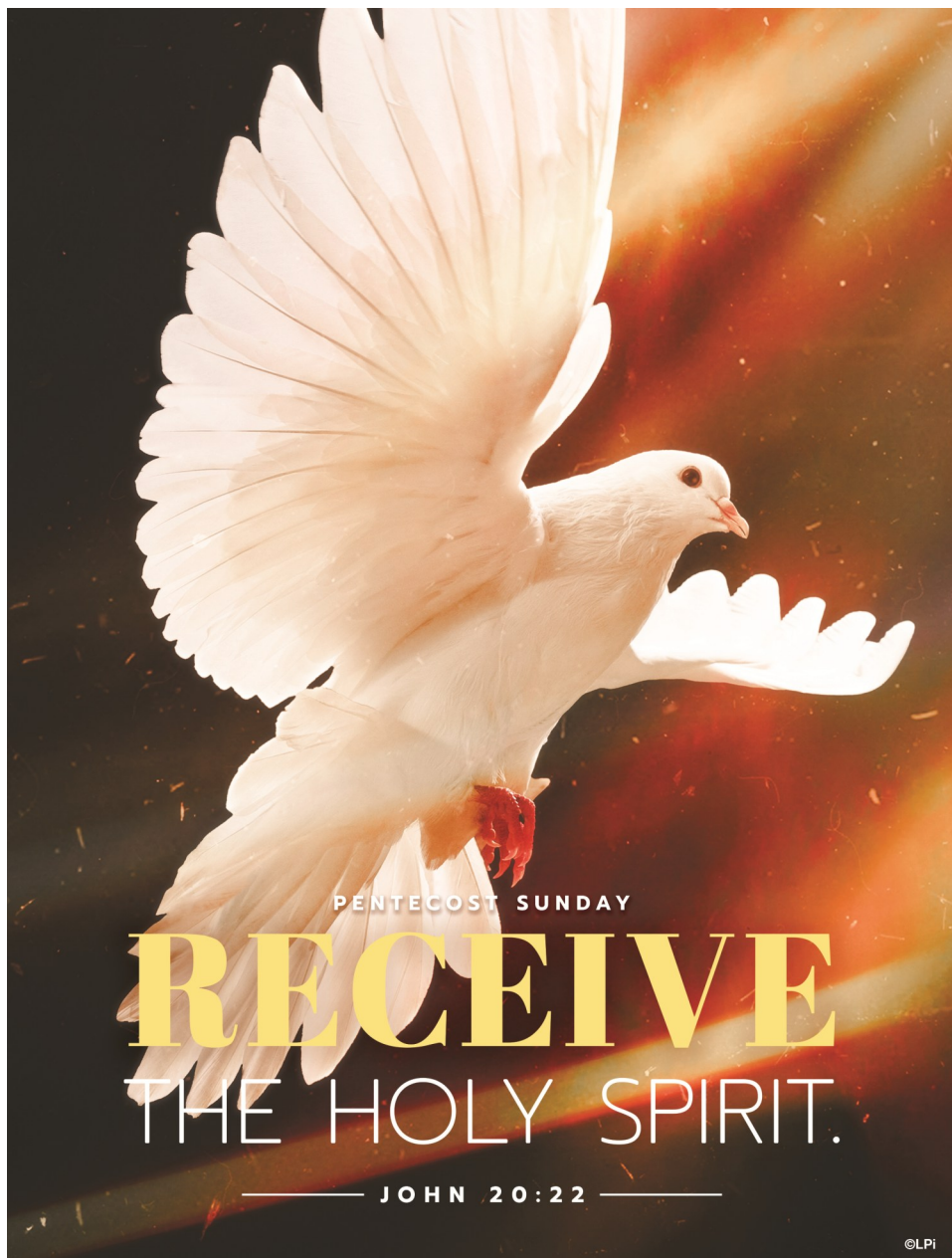

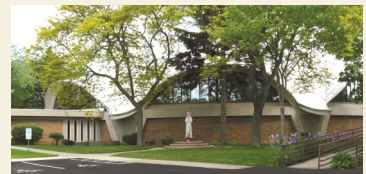

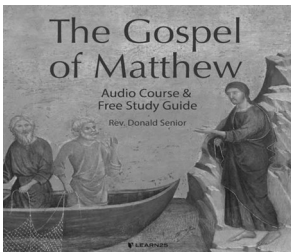

Gospel Reflection: John 20:19-23

"Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." John 20:21

Breathed into Being ~ On the evening of that first day of the week, the disciples were huddled behind locked doors—frightened, uncertain, and far from the world outside. Into that closed and fearful room, the risen Christ appeared, not with rebuke, but with the single word they most needed: *peace*. His greeting was not merely a comfort; it was a commissioning. The same peace He offered, He sent them out to carry into the world. Then Jesus did something remarkable: He breathed on them, echoing the very breath of God that once gave life to dust in the Garden of Eden. With that breath came the Holy Spirit—not a distant power, but the intimate presence of God moving within and among them. On Pentecost, we remember that the Spirit is given not so we may stay behind locked doors, but so that we may fling them open in love and courage. The authority to forgive others releases them from the weight of sin and shame. This authority is entrusted to a community shaped and empowered by this holy, life-giving breath. Today we celebrate that we, too, are that community: sent, filled, and sustained by the very breath of the risen Christ to be bearers of His peace.

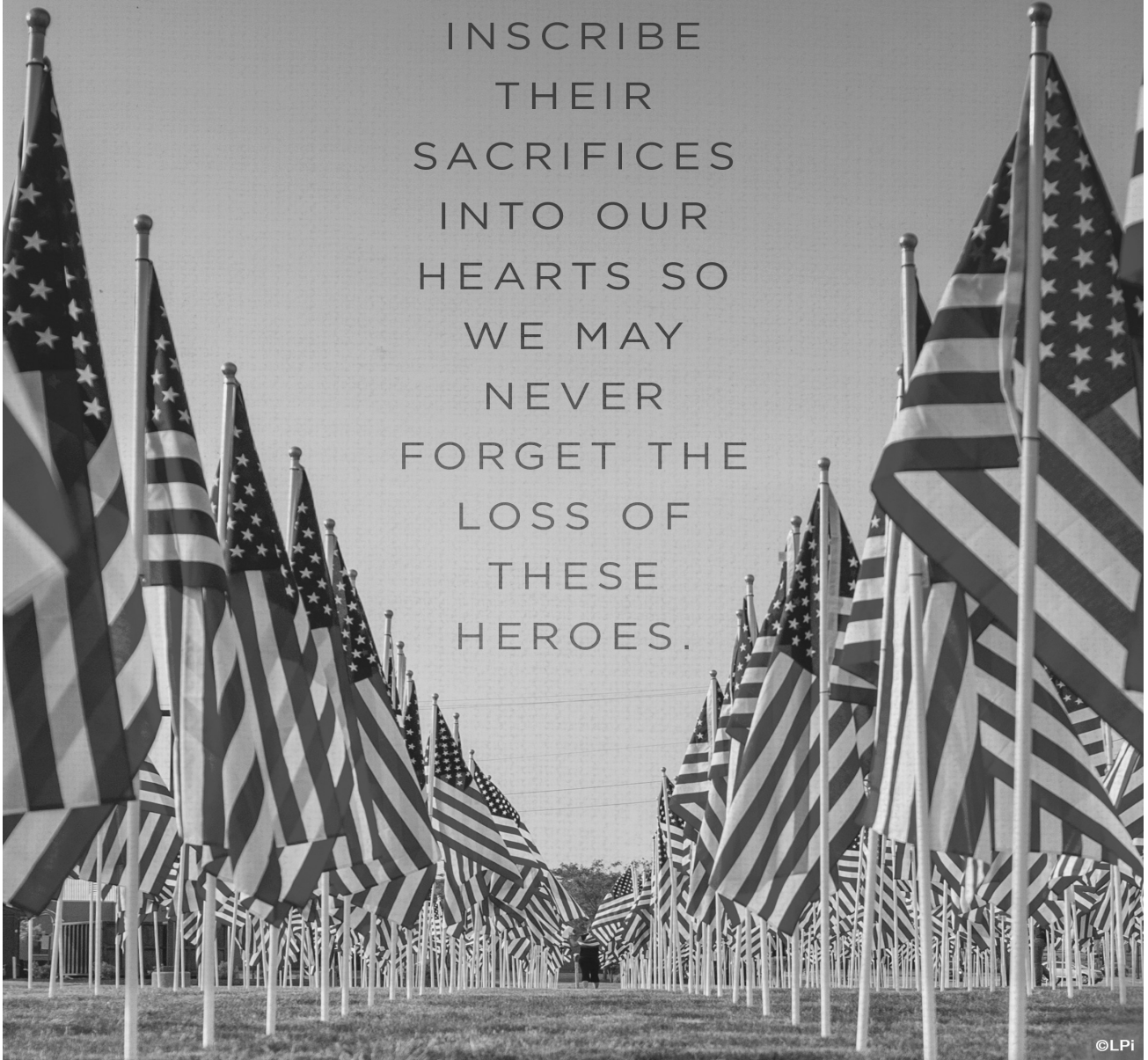
Online evening prayer with young adults

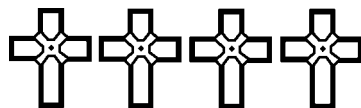
