Gospel reflection ~ Matthew 5:16-37

In today's Gospel, Jesus challenges us to move beyond mere external observance of the law to embrace its deeper spiritual meaning. He doesn't abolish the commandments but fulfills them, calling us to a righteousness that penetrates the heart rather than stopping at outward behavior. When Jesus speaks of anger, lust, and honesty, He reveals that sin begins in our interior lives, in the thoughts and desires we harbor before they ever become actions. This teaching can feel overwhelming, as it exposes how far we all fall short of God's perfect holiness. Yet Christ doesn't leave us in despair; by showing us the ideal, He invites us to rely on His grace rather than our own strength. The impossibly high standard Jesus sets demonstrates our need for a Savior who can transform us from within. As we reflect on these words, we are called to examine not just what we do, but who we are becoming in our hearts. This Sunday reminds us that authentic Christian life is about allowing God's love to reshape our deepest motivations, making us people of integrity whose inner and outer lives align with the Gospel. ~ Blessings, Fr. Lent: Missionary Discipleship

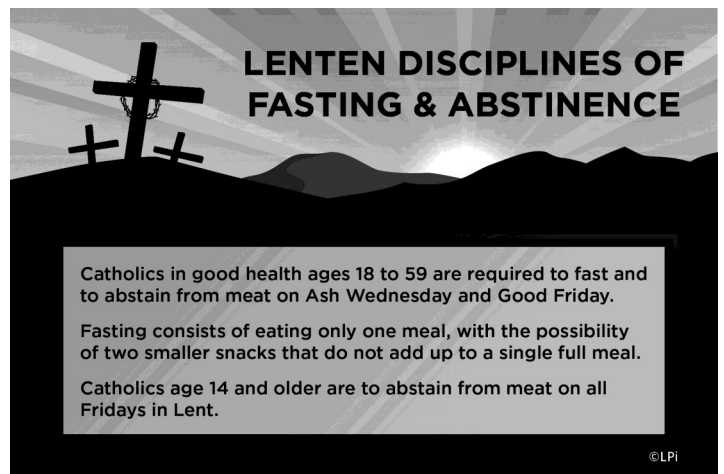

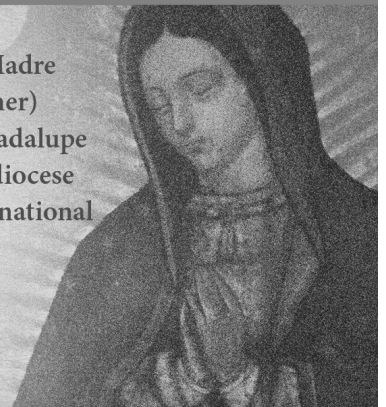

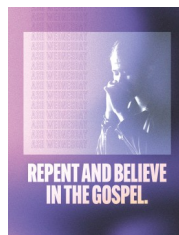
