Bingo volunteers needed

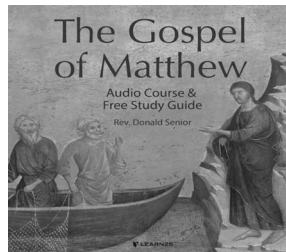

Gospel Reflection: John 6:51-58

The Harvest Is Plentiful ~ Matthew 9:36-10:8

“When he saw the crowds, he had compassion for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.” Matthew 9:36

When Jesus looked out at the crowds that followed Him, He did not see a burden. He saw people who were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd, and His heart was moved with deep compassion.

This compassion was not passive; it compelled Him to act, first by naming the urgent reality: the harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few.

Jesus calls us to begin where He began—not with strategy or program, but with prayer, asking the Lord of the harvest to send workers into His field.

From that posture of prayer, Jesus summoned the Twelve and gave them authority not for their own glory, but to extend the very work He had been doing among the lost. Notice that the mission is concrete: heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, cast out demons. The kingdom of God arrives as good news made visible in human lives.

The disciples were sent to “the lost sheep of the house of Israel,” reminding us that God’s compassion always moves toward the most vulnerable and forgotten first. The instruction “you received without payment; give without payment” strips away any temptation to treat grace as a commodity. What God freely gives, we freely share.

Today we are invited to see our neighbors as Jesus saw the crowds—with eyes of compassion—and to ask ourselves how we are being called to labor in the harvest that surrounds us. ~ Blessings, Fr. Mark Payne

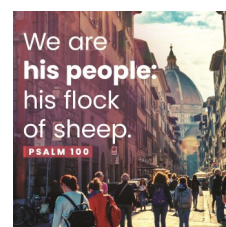
