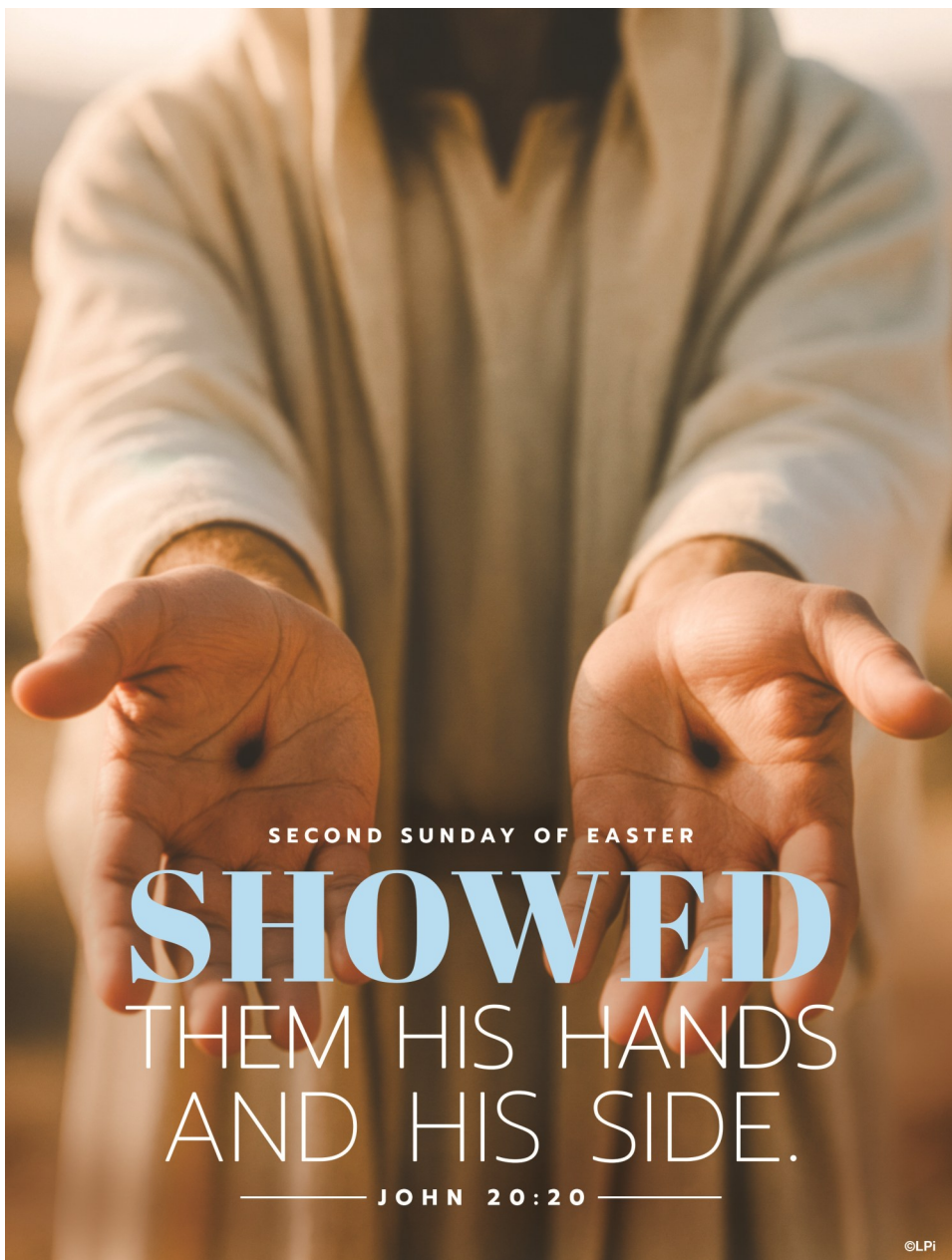

Gospel reflection ~ John 20:19-31

On the evening of the first day of the week, the risen Christ appears to His frightened disciples behind locked doors, offering not condemnation for their hiding, but the gift of peace. His first words, "Peace be with you," remind us that the Resurrection does not begin with demands, but with grace. Jesus shows them His hands and His side, grounding their joy not in wishful thinking, but in the reality of His wounded, glorified body. He then sends them just as the Father sent Him, breathing the Holy Spirit upon them and commissioning them to carry His forgiveness into the world. Thomas, who was absent that evening, voices the doubt that many of us quietly carry, an unwillingness to believe without seeing for ourselves. Yet Jesus does not shame Thomas; instead, He returns specifically for him, meeting him exactly where he is and inviting him to touch the wounds he needs to see. Thomas's response "My Lord and my God!" is one of the most profound professions of faith in all of Scripture, born not despite his doubt, but through it. Finally, Jesus offers a gentle blessing to all who will follow Thomas: "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed," a word of encouragement meant for every one of us gathered here today. ~ Blessings, Fr.
