
The parish offices will be closed all Fridays during the month of July, unless arrangements are made with the pastoral staff for appointments/meetings.



The Archdiocese of Milwaukee has a zero-tolerance policy regarding the sexual abuse of a minor.


If you or someone you know is being abused, or you suspect abuse is occurring, contact your local law enforcement department immediately.
