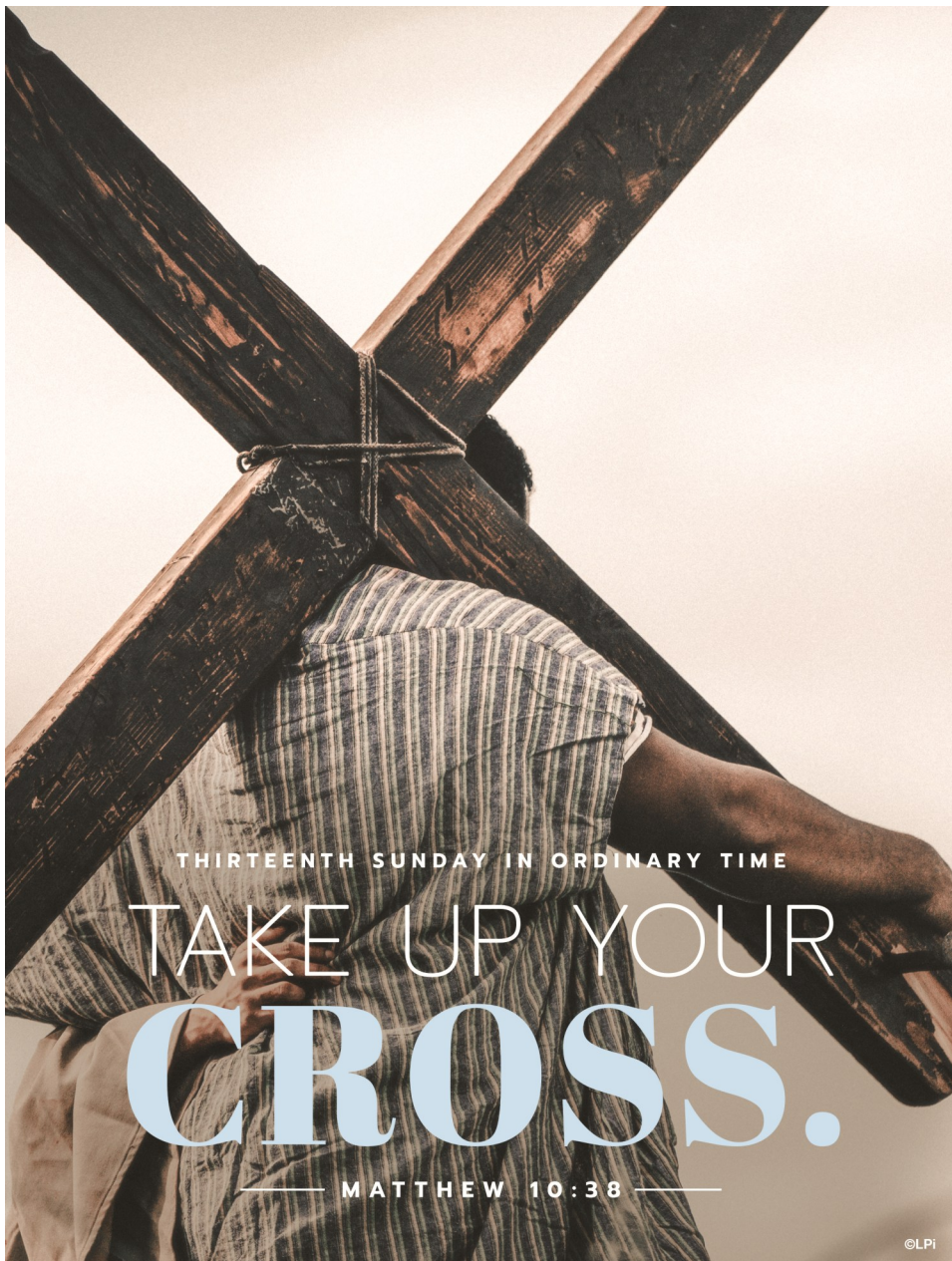

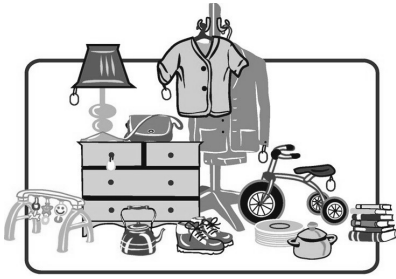

## Bingo volunteers needed

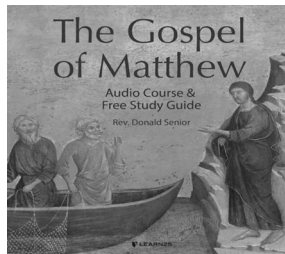

## Gospel Reflection

*"Whoever loves his father or mother more than me is not worthy of me." —Matthew 10:37*

Jesus does not ask us to love our families less, but rather to place our love for God at the very center of every other love we hold dear.

In today's Gospel, Christ presents us with a radical invitation: to reorder our deepest loyalties around the kingdom of God rather than around the comfortable securities of this world.

The image of taking up the cross is not a call to suffering for its own sake, but a call to follow the path of self-giving love that leads to true and lasting life. When we lose our lives for Christ's sake, we discover that what we release was never the fullness of life at all, only a shadow of the abundant life He promises.

The passage then turns tender: even the smallest act of welcome given in Christ's name—a cup of cold water offered to someone in need—carries eternal weight. God does not measure our discipleship by grand gestures alone, but by the quiet fidelity we show in ordinary moments of hospitality and care.

This week, we are invited to examine where we place our ultimate trust and to ask whether our daily choices reflect a heart ordered toward God. May we be people who receive Christ in every person we encounter, and in that receiving, find ourselves drawn ever closer to the One who is our life and our hope.

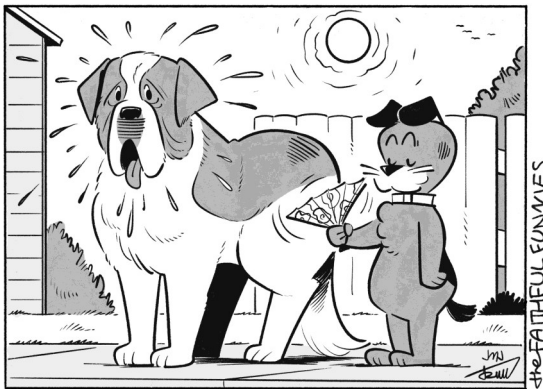
## Reading tutors needed at NWCS
